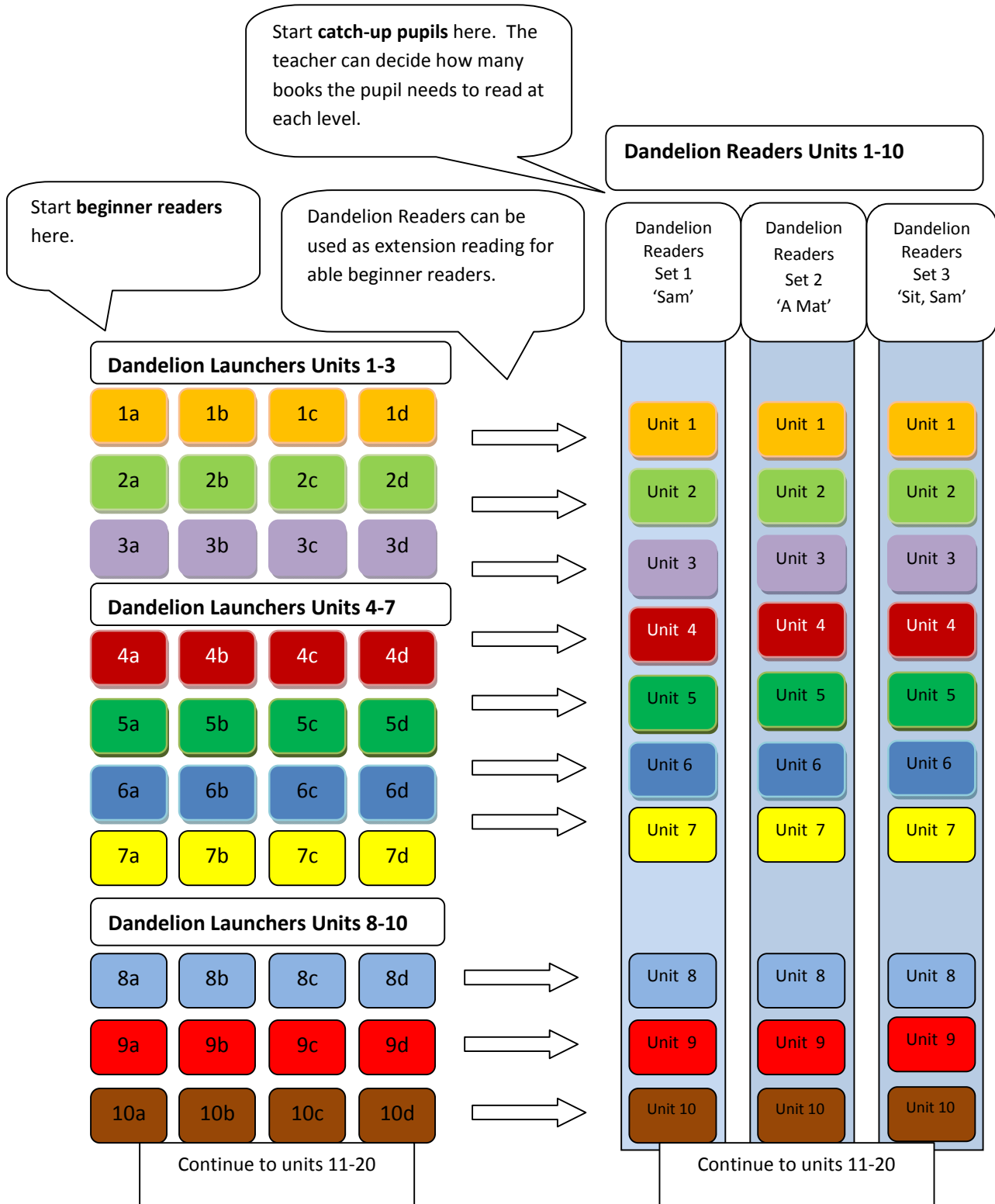


How to use Dandelion Books

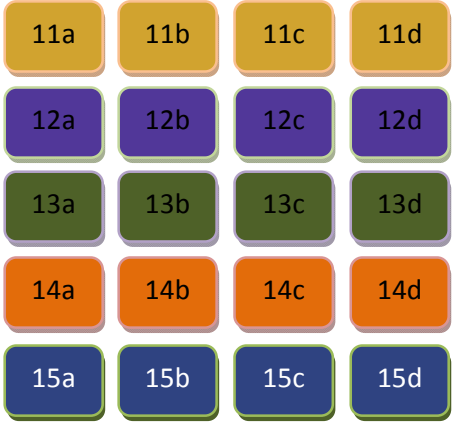
Units 1-10: Phase 2 of 'Letters and Sounds'

Dandelion Launchers Series and Dandelion Readers Series follow the same phonic progression and can be used together. Dandelion Launchers have 1-2 lines of text per page. Dandelion Readers has 3-4 lines of text per page (from Unit 3 onwards). Every level is called a 'Unit'. The teacher can decide the level of text suitable for the pupil. Below are rough guidelines of where to start the pupil in the series. Workbooks that complement these series offer further opportunities to practise phonic skills and knowledge at each stage.

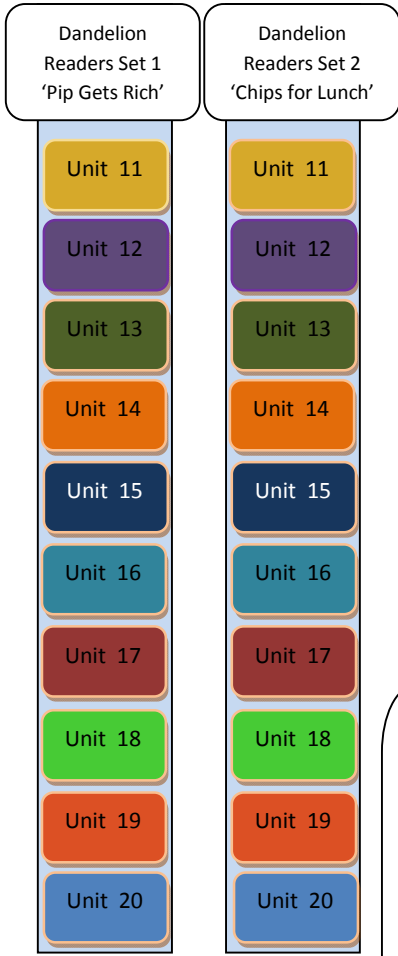


How to use Dandelion Books

Continue to Levels 1, 2, 3, and 4.
 The sounds introduced in Levels 1-3 follow the same phonic sequence. Each level introduces more spelling alternatives.
 Levels 1, 2 and 3 books can also be read vertically e.g.:
 Level 1, Book 1; Level 2, Book 1; Level 3, Book 1.

Split Vowel Spellings Set is for readers who need extra practice reading words with split vowels.

Level 1, Phase 3 of 'Letters and Sounds'



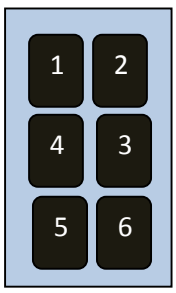
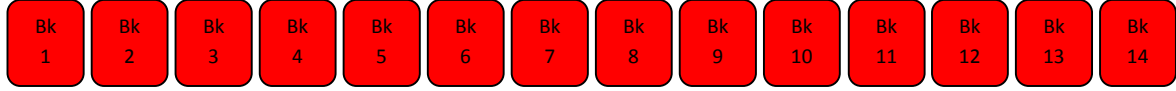
Level 2, Phase 5 of 'Letters and Sounds'
