prefix	root	word	literal meaning	definition
re (back)	spect (look, regard)	respect (v)	look back	to regard someone with admiration or esteem
in (into)	spect (look, regard)	inspect (v)	look into	to look or examine something closely to see it is alright
a (at, to)	spect (look, regard)	aspect (n)	look at	the way something appears, a feature of something
pro (forward)	spect (look, regard)	prospect (n)	look forward	the possibility of something good happening in the future
intro (into)	spect (look, regard)	introspective (adj)	look into	considering one's own ideas, thoughts and feelings
retro (back)	spect (look, regard)	retrospective (adj)	look back	relating to the past or something that has happened in the past
per (through)	spect (look, regard)	perspective (n)	look through	a point of view
circum (around)	spect (look, regard)	circumspect (adj)	look around on all sides	cautious, wary, unwilling to take risks
