peek – look quickly

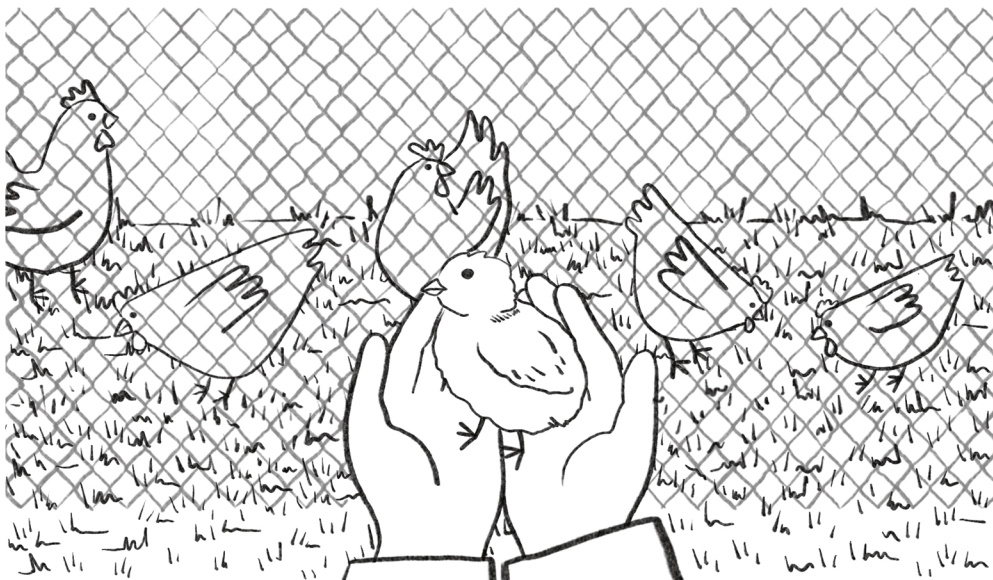
