affect (verb)

Definition: to change or influence something

Use syllables and phonemes to decode and encode:

a **f** **f** | **e** **c** **t**
/ɑ/ /f/ /e/ /k/ /t/

Use morphemes to comprehend:

af

af = 'toward'
(from Latin)

fect

facere = 'to do'
(from Latin)

(from Latin)

fect

facere = 'to do'
(from Latin)
